The Bronx Concert Singers' 34th Annual Holiday Concert

Bronx, NY – November 5, 2015 –On <u>Sunday afternoon, December 13, 2015 at 4:30 pm</u>, The Bronx Concert Singers, under the direction of Music Director Robert René Galván, will present our **34**th **Annual Holiday Concert** at St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church, 1891 McGraw Avenue, in Parkchester, Bronx, NY 10462.

Music Director Robert René Galván's warm palette of songs from three continents is your invitation to this joyous Holiday concert. Three works by Vivaldi may have you putting him on your holiday wish list: "Magnificat" [RV610] overflows with drama and vigor in its 9 movements, *Allegro I* from Concerto for 4 Violins [RV580] demands virtuosity as well as passion, while *Largo II* from Concerto for 2 Oboes [RV 535] is the calm before the fireworks. Ariel Ramirez infuses *Gloria* (from "Misa Criolla") with beloved folk melodies from Argentina's sweeping pampas. Stanford's *Beati Quorum Via* is a 6 part cascade of interlocking melody. Scarlatti's *Exultate Deo* is an exultant song of praise, while his soprano aria *Toccó la prima sorte a voi, pastori* (from "Christmas Cantata") evokes the shepherds' pastoral watch at Bethlehem. The program is rounded out by *Jamaican Carol*, the African-American spiritual *Go Tell It on the Mountain*, and additional seasonal favorites. The 25 member chorus will be joined by professional soloists and chamber orchestra.
