One: Do not, O Lord, withhold your mercy from me;

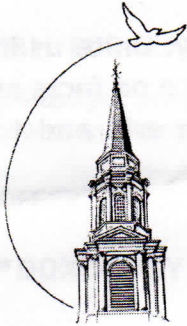
Many: let your steadfast love and your faithfulness keep me safe forever.

One: One thing I asked of the Lord, that I will seek after;

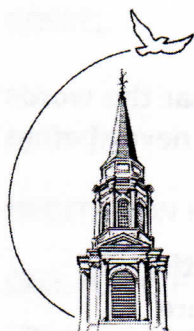
Many: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life,
