

THE BRONX CONCERT SINGERS

The Bronx Concert Singers is a membership of enthusiastic people who enrich their lives and the cultural life of the Bronx through the art of choral singing. It includes persons of all ages, from all walks of life, who are committed to developing their musical potential in the spirit of friendship and mutual support.

Established in 1981, The Bronx Concert Singers began concertizing in Spring, 1982. The chorus has given concerts with orchestra in churches and concert halls throughout the city and Westchester County, including Merkin Hall at Lincoln Center. The chorus made its Carnegie Hall debut in June, 2005, in a multi-choral performance of Mozart's *Requiem* (Levin completion).

Past programs have offered a wide variety in musical styles, ranging from major oratorios with orchestra to folk songs and other popular music. In June, 2005, the chorus presented the New York Premiere of Lettie Beckon Alston's *Conquest of Jericho*, for which Dr. Alston was pianist. In May, 2004, the Singers celebrated the lifework of Jamaican composer and educator Noel Dexter with a gala concert in which Mr. Dexter was an enthusiastic collaborator as well as guest of honor. And in 1997, the Singers gave the North American Premiere performance of the $\underline{\textit{Mass in F}}$ by Padre Jose Mauricio Nunez Garcia, a black Brazilian composer who lived at the beginning of the nineteenth century.

The Bronx Concert Singers invite singers of all voice parts to join them for an unforgettable experience that combines hard work, abundant laughter, and the thrill of performing great music. New members are always welcome, pending audition, to join in September for the winter concert, and in January for the spring concert. Rehearsals are held every Tuesday evening from 7:30 to 10:00 PM at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Parkchester, 1891 McGraw Ave., Bronx. Dues are collected to help defray the group's expenses.
